

In April and May 2018, 6 480 students from 213 schools representing 32313 fifteen-year-olds in Bosnia and Herzegovina



...took a 2-hour test in mathematics, reading and science.



Two types of questionnaires were used to gather information about students, teachers and schools for better understanding of test scores and evaluating factors that affect student achievement, especially equality and equity.



The results are product of cumulative effects of individual traits, family, environment and school resources on students.



In Bosnia and Herzegovina, most students enrolled grade 1 of secondary education and a smaller number completed grade 9 of primary education.



79 countries participated in PISA 2018 program and their results are comparable to the results of more than 80 countries that have participated in this program so far.
