



In Bosnia and Herzegovina 77% of students estimate they are satisfied and very satisfied with their lives, while 11% are not satisfied.



Students in Bosnia and Herzegovina have positive attitudes towards education. Over 85% believe the education will provide better future and employment and that effort in education pays off.



Some 90% of socio-economically advantaged students think the effort at school will help them enrol a good faculty while 80% of socio-economically disadvantaged students think the effort at school will help them find a good job.



Generally, students are more likely to experience positive than negative emotions, which is more often reported by advantaged students than by disadvantaged students.



In Bosnia and Herzegovina one in two 15-year-olds expect to graduate from university. Some 73% of advantaged students expect to graduate from university while 32% of disadvantaged students also believe so.



Some 93% of students with high scores believe to graduate from university at least in one course while 40% of students with low scores expect the same.
