

Bosnia and Herzegovina allocates 4% of the country's gross domestic product and 9% of total public expenditure on education.



The average teacher-student ratio in Bosnia and Herzegovina is 7 students per teacher, while OECD average is 15. The average number of students in the class is 22.



As for extracurricular activities, schools mostly offer sports activities while cooperation with local authorities is little.



90% of principals believe the teaching process is not or is very little limited due to the lack, or inadequacy, of teaching and professional staff.



Some 32% of schools have enough digital teaching devices and 56% of them have satisfactory availability of software that enhances the teaching and learning process.



In 45% of schools in Bosnia and Herzegovina, principals find that they have little or no difficulty with inadequate or insufficient infrastructure.



30% of school principals in Bosnia and Herzegovina estimate that a lack of didactic resources does not present a major difficulty in teaching.
